This plant will allow local economy diversification. It will produce in the near future an assortment of solid fuels (pellets, briquettes, logs, etc.) coming from our regional forest biomass. On top of creating permanent employment this plant, according to Ecoflamme, should become the igniters for the development of regional renewable energies.

The preliminary results ordered by FP Innovations, a known forest research organization, are very encouraging. The different aimed materials would enable Ecoflamme to produce their targeted fuels. This exhaustive study took two years of work by different partners and was realized in cooperation with different Provincial and Federal Government ministries and organizations.

Ecoflamme is presently working on the financial aspect of the project. The building of the plant will be next step. The opening of the plant is scheduled for the summer of 2009. There exists presently a shortage of pellets for domestic as well as industrial use. This project represents a safe investment sheltered from economic cycles. Our young enterprise is presently looking for financial partners wishing to position themselves in this very promising energy notch.
